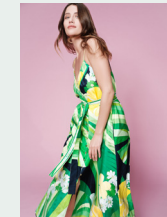

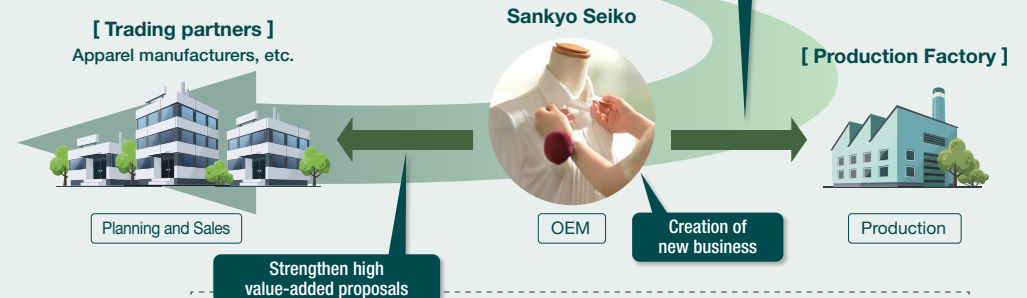
- French luxury maison established in 1958

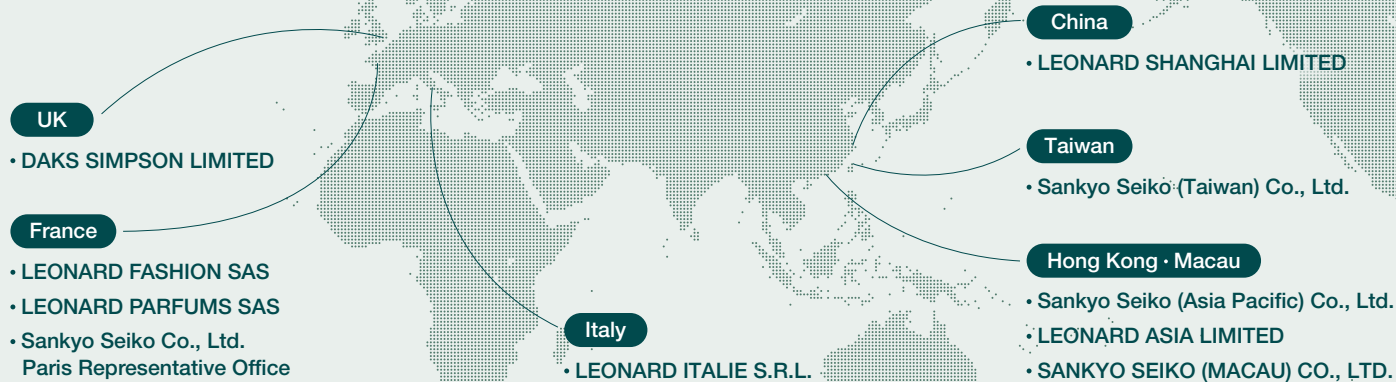

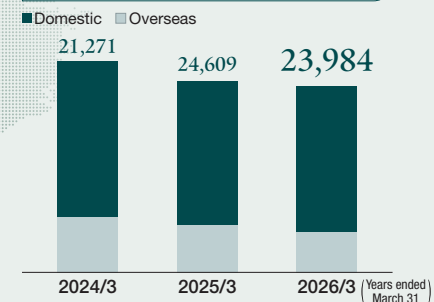

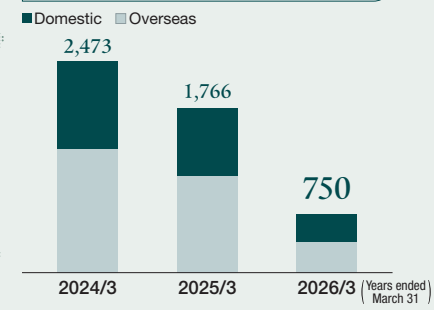


Net Sales (Millions of yen)
